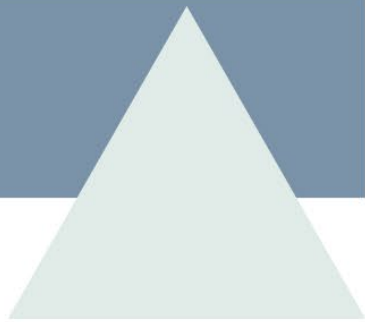


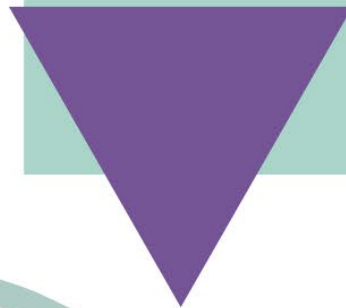

Registration for the 12th World Congress and the 5th TOS Conference is open!

The 12th World Congress will have a 5-day program (**23-27 July**).

- Arrival 22 July or earlier
- July 22: Check-in 4-8 PM
- July 23: Check-in 7-9 AM
- July 23-27: World Congress programs
- July 28: Full-day Tours (optional)

The 5th TOS International Conference with a 2-day program (**27-29 July**).

- July 27: Check-in 6-7 PM, Opening 7 PM at the Congress place
- July 27-29: TOS Conference program (start evening of 27th)
- July 30: Full-day tours (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS TO REGISTER - TWO ONLINE ACTIONS REQUIRED

Registrations are open from July 2024. You need to make two online actions to register. They need not be made at the same time.

- A. Register for the World Congress and/or TOS Conference
 - Registration requires payment to be made. Only then you will receive confirmation.
- B. Book Accommodation at UBC
 - Reservation for a room asks for your credit card but the payment is made only when checking in to the room.

CANCELLATION

Registration can be cancelled by 30th June 2025. You will be refunded the amount you paid with a reduction of 35 CAD (administrative fee) and the registration fee (non-refundable).

Accommodation can be canceled up to 72h before the check-in date with no charges.




FULL-DAY TOUR OPTIONS for 28 and 30 July 2025

Tour 1: Capilano Bridge Tour		120 CAD	Capilano Suspension Bridge + River Hatchery: A trip to experience the rainforests. You need to be able to enjoy wobbling across bridges and being up high.
Tour 2: Garden Tour		45 CAD	This tour includes visits to Van Dusen Garden, Queen Elizabeth Park and MacMillan Bloedel Conservatory.
Tour 3: Boat Cruises		160 CAD	Take a ride in the Vancouver Harbour and Indian Arm-boats to a big lake/gulf.
Tour4: The Peak of Vancouver		130 CAD	This tour includes a gondola ride to Grouse Mountain, the peak of Vancouver, and events at the top of the mountain.
Tour 5: Excursion		30 CAD	Capilano River Hatchery, Lynn Canyon Suspension Bridge, short hike, swimming at 30 foot pool and walk at Cates Park. Definitely need to be fit for this trip.

- For room types 1-2, non-family members under the age of 19 are not permitted to share a bed.
- The two accommodation buildings (Gage and Orchard) are located at a walking distance from the Congress Hall. It takes 8 minutes for Gage rooms "1" to "5", and 13 minutes for Orchard rooms "6".
